Safety Instructions

1. Keep the *safety cork* on the needle ANY time the unit is not in use.





- **2.** Be sure that there is plenty of clearance between the player and spectators.
- 3. Keep spectators clear from the sides and back of canvas to prevent them from being struck by a deflected or errant throw.
- **4.** If using game outdoors, it is strongly suggested that you use the stakes provided on either side of the bottom supports. Use sandbags on pavement. And in a breeze, use sandbags with the stakes.
- 5. NEVER USE THE GAME IN STRONG WINDS OR LIGHTENING!!
- **6.** Use caution when setting up or taking down the game. The sections of tubing can come apart and fall down causing injury.
- 7. Use only the balls included with the game.
- 8. Be sure to clean up any balloon pieces. These can be a choking hazard to small children.

Assembly Instructions

- 1. Select a level area to operate game with plenty of room to allow for a line to form.
- **2.** Assemble framework, per *Frame Set-up picture*. (Be sure to tighten down the fittings using the small bolts on them.)
- **3.** Attach canvas to the framework using the Velcro straps. [*NOTE:* Your canvas is powdered to prevent it from sticking together during shipment. Simply remove powder with a dry cloth.]
- 4. If using game outdoors, it is strongly suggested that you use the stakes provided on either side of the bottom supports. Use sandbags on pavement. And in a breeze, use sandbags with the stakes.
- **5.** Screw on the target.
- 6. Place the harness with the balloon on the pipe to the left (when facing unit). Be sure the needle lines up with the balloon.
- 7. The *Splash Bombs* are meant to be thrown wet. Keep a bucket of water nearby to soak them in.
- 8. Use only helium balloons.
- 9. If using indoors, purchase a small wading pool to contain the water.

CANVAS CARE

- 1. NEVER store game with the safety cork off the needle, as it will slice the canvas and could be dangerous.
- 2. If game becomes wet, dry thoroughly before storing.
- 3. Fold the canvas INWARD to help protect and keep it clean.
- 4. Canvas can be cleaned with mild soap when necessary.
